

How to Keep Your IU Email After You Graduate

Background:

Unless you are continuing at an IU campus as a employee or student, your IU email will be deactivated around February. (For details, see <http://kb.iu.edu/data/auox.html>.) The university has contracted with Google and Microsoft to host @iupui.edu and @indiana.edu email addresses. Redirecting to one of those would make for a smooth transition:

Keep your IU email address after you graduate --

Graduating students now have multiple options for continued IU email: An IU Alumni Association (Windows Live Hotmail) account, an Imail account (powered by Microsoft), and/or a Umail account (powered by Google).

These accounts can seamlessly replace your soon-to-be-retired student webmail, if you create your account shortly after graduation and set your IU student webmail or Exchange to start forwarding to either your Alumni, Imail, or Umail account.
